



RMS33 Cast Iron Drop-in Apron Farmhouse Kitchen Sink Installation Procedures

Cabinet Sink Support Frame Preparation:

1. Inside the open cabinet area and right below the sink location a “Sink Support Frame” is to be installed to accommodate a minimum weight load of 350 lbs.
2. Measure the actual outside dimensions of the sink to determine the support frame size and location.
3. Provide the proper clearance for the faucet, water supply lines, drain assembly, garbage disposal and cabinet structure.
4. Install the sink support frame so that the sink is level and flush with the top surface of the countertop.

Countertop Sink Mounting Installation:

1. Use the supplied sink template to layout the sink opening onto the countertop and cut out accordingly.
2. Install the countertop onto the cabinet and position the opening so it correctly aligns over the sink support frame.
3. Apply a thin layer of sealant around the edge of the sink support frame and the edge of the sink rim.
4. Set the sink into the countertop opening making sure that the rim of the sink is sitting uniformly on the countertop, and the bottom of the sink is sitting properly on the sink support frame.

NOTE: WEIGHT OF THE SINK TO BE SUPPORTED BY THE “SINK SUPPORT FRAME” NOT THE COUNTERTOP.

Faucet Installation:

1. Install the faucet as per the manufactures instructions.
2. Provide adequate clearance for the hot & cold water supply lines, faucet and sink operation.
3. Separately and slowly open the hot & cold water supply lines checking all pipe connections for leaks.

Drain Installation:

1. Install the Basket Strainer and P-Trap Drain Assembly in accordance with the manufactures instructions.
2. Provide adequate clearance for the sink and faucet operation.
3. While filling the sink basin run water through the drain piping checking all pipe connections for leaks.

NOTE: IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE INSTALLATION BE PERFORMED BY A LICENSED PLUMBER AND ALL WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL LOCAL PLUMBING AND BUILDING CODE REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN WARRANTY.
