

Shower Drain Installation Guide

This bathroom fixture has been carefully engineered to provide a long, trouble-free service life under normal usage. It has been factory-tested and is ready for installation. We suggest this fixture be installed by a qualified licensed plumber so the warranty will remain in affect (refer to the "General Information" insert for warranty information). We also strongly recommend tub & hardware be on site prior to rough in.

- 1. Insert the drain gasket into the drain flange coupling.
- 2. Insert the drain outlet into the metal gasket and place in the desired position. Adjust or remove the drain feet if necessary.
- 3. Place pea gravel over the drain flange coupling weep holes and around the perimeter to prevent mortar from filling and blocking the holes.
- 4. Apply mortar over the waterproof shower pan liner, starting from the drain and continuing to the wall. Using a level, create a 1-2° slope from the wall to the drain.
- 5. Allow the mortar to cure.
- 6. Once the tiling and grouting are complete, apply a thin bead of silicone sealant around the drain to fill any gaps between the drain and tile.
